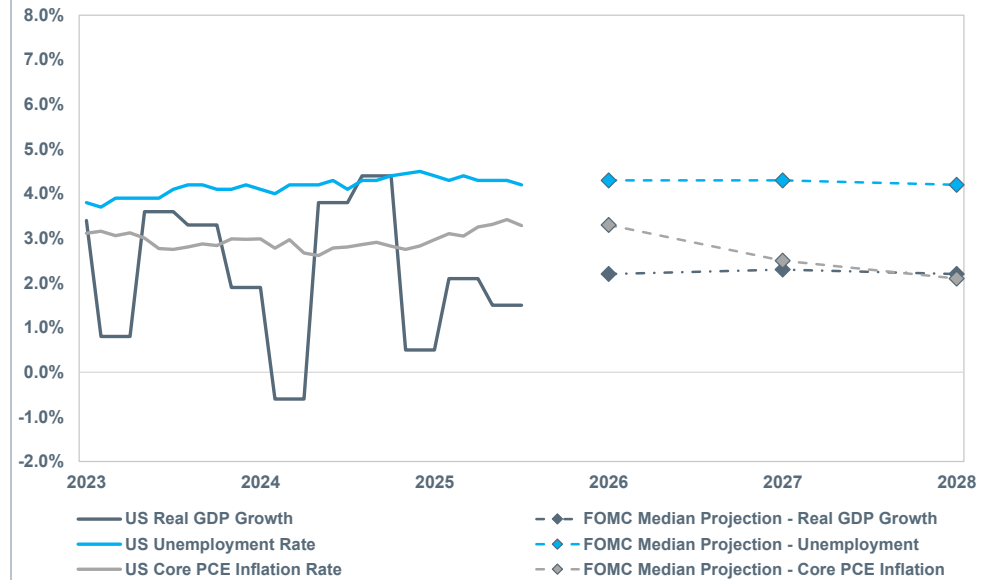


General Market Commentary

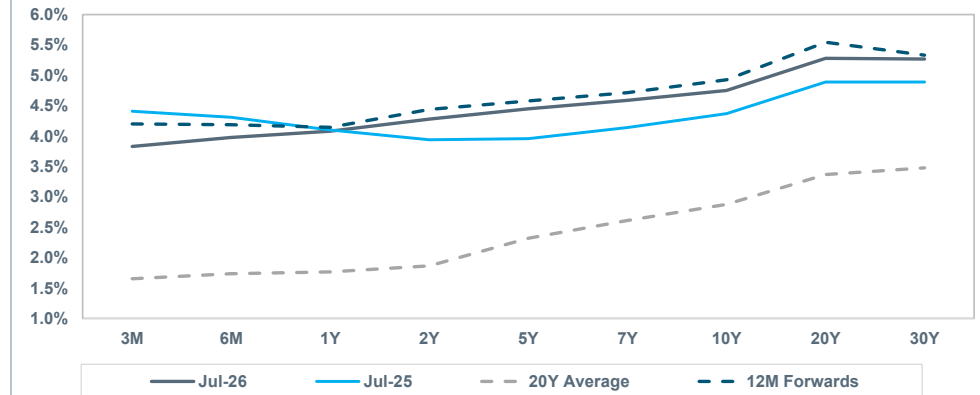
- Renewed conflict in the Middle East drove energy prices higher, raising concerns about the impact of a prolonged conflict on energy markets and inflation.
- At its second meeting under Chair Kevin Warsh, the FOMC held the federal funds target rate steady, with three dissenting votes favoring a 25 bps increase.
- Long-term interest rates rose sharply, with the 30-year Treasury reaching its highest level since 2007. In fixed income, short-duration, floating-rate, and non-USD exposures delivered the strongest returns for the month.
- Technology was the weakest equity sector as semiconductor stocks gave back a portion of their first-half gains, causing growth benchmarks to lag value benchmarks globally. U.S. small-cap and emerging market equities each declined about 3% during the month but remain among the strongest performing equity categories year to date.
